

JOSÉ LUIS TEMES MONTES

José Luis Temes has a **PhD in Medicine (Summa Cum Laude)**, is a Specialist in Internal Medicine and Nephrology and has a Master's in Business Management. He has been practicing medicine as a Specialist in Nephrology for ten years.

He has been **Manager** of the following hospitals:

1984 · 1986. Orense University Hospital Complex, a public hospital currently belonging to the Galician Health Service. The Hospital Complex serves a population of 330,000, with 929 beds, providing all medical and surgical specialities and having an annual budget of 132 million euros.

1986 · 1989. Marqués de Valdecilla de Santander University Hospital, a public hospital serving a population of 600,000 people, with 874 beds providing all medical and surgical specialities and having an annual budget of 336 million euros.

1989 · 1991. La Paz de Madrid University Hospital, a Hospital Complex that is a European reference, consisting of five main hospitals: General Hospital, Maternity Hospital, Children's Hospital, Orthopaedic and Rehabilitation Hospital, and the Cantoblanco Hospital. The population assigned to the La Paz U.H. is some 500,000 people, it has 1,228 beds and an annual budget of 437 million euros.

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The La Paz Hospital has over 45 medical specialities and is a reference in training and advanced specialisation.

1992 · 1993. Jiménez Díaz Foundation, a private hospital which is highly prestigious for training medical specialists and with an important nursing school; it has 665 beds, with a budget of 270 million euros.

1993 · 1994. General Director of the National Health Institute, the entity managing the Social Security system responsible for healthcare, under the Ministry of Health and Consumption, at that time it was the second largest undertaking in Europe in respect of number of employees, only preceded by the Deutsche Bundespost.

It had 150,000 employees.

It worked with 6 General Subdirectorates:

- General Subdirectorate for General Secretariat
- General Subdirectorate for Budgets
- General Subdirectorate for Personnel
- General Subdirectorate for Construction and Installations Management
- General Subdirectorate for Primary Health Care
- General Subdirectorate for Specialist Health Care.

1994 · 1996. Under-Secretary at the Ministry of Health, Deputy Minister of the Spanish Government.

Six administrative centres with the ranking of General Directorate are dependent on the Under-Secretariat –as the second hierarchical level in the Ministry.

- General Directorate for Public Health
- General Directorate for Professional Planning
- General Directorate for Research Planning
- General Directorate for Pharmaceuticals and Medical Products
- General Management of the Carlos III Health Institute (Research)
- General Directorate of the National Health School (Training).

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During this period he attended meetings of the Ministers of Consumption of the European Union as the representative of the Spanish Government.

1994 · 1996. Consellour of Caja Postal Argentaria and Argentaria Merchant Bank. Nowadays both are integrated into the BBVA (Banco Bilbao Vizcaya Argentaria), one of the largest European banks.

1996 · 2000. General Manager of the Reina Sofía de Cordoba University Hospital, a public hospital serving a population of 408,925 people, with 1,197 beds, providing all medical and surgical specialities and having an annual budget of 321 million euros.

He has published five editions of ***Gestión Hospitalaria*** (*Hospital Management*) with the publishers **McGraw-Hill Interamericana** in 1992, 1997, 2002, 2007 and 2011 (5th edition), ***El Coste por Proceso Hospitalario*** (*The Cost per Hospital Procedure*), in 1994, ***El Sistema Nacional de Salud*** (*The National Health System*) in 1997, ***Gestión Clínica*** (*Clinical Management*) in 2000, and ***Gestión de Procesos Asistenciales: Aplicación Práctica*** (*Management of healthcare Procedures: Practical Application*), in 2006.

He is the author of numerous publications and papers in scientific journals and congresses.

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He has been requested by the Health Authorities and professional associations of different countries (Bahrain, Bolivia, Chile, El Salvador, Guatemala, Mexico, Nicaragua, Peru and the Dominican Republic) as an **expert in Health Systems and Hospital Management**

For 20 years he has been a **lecturer** at the **Autonomous** and **Complutense Universities in Madrid, Cordoba University** and **Cantabria University**.
